


Nursery Literacy Grid

<p>Character Mask</p> <p>Can you make a character mask of your favourite story character? Paper plates are great for making masks but if you don't have any card or paper will do. You could cut up an empty cereal box to use.</p> 	<p>Sound Hunt</p> <p>Can you find items in your house beginning with...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> *m *a *s *t *p 	<p>Rhyming Game</p> <p>Can you match the words in this list to their rhyming partners?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> *cat *log *ten *bat *dog *car *star *hen <p>Can you make a rhyming string like mine? Cat, bat, rat, sat, mat.</p>	<p>Favourite Story Character</p> <p>Draw or paint a picture of your favourite story character or scene from your favourite story book. Can you think of words to describe them?</p> 
<p>Go on a Bear Hunt</p> <p>Read the story 'We're Going on a Bear Hunt' if you have it. If not you can watch it online https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Waoa3iG3bZ4</p> <p>Hide soft toy bears or other soft toy characters around your house for your child to find. Go on a bear hunt and collect them all up. How many bears did you find?</p> 	<p>Find my Name</p> <p>Adult- Write child's name on some post-it notes or alternatively pieces of paper and hide them around the house. Ask your child to find their name. Once they have found all of the names they can attempt to write their name. Think of a main character, a place and an event. What happens in the beginning, middle and end of your story? It could be a silly story.</p> 	<p>The Tiger Who Came to Tea</p> <p>Read the story 'The Tiger Who Came to Tea' if you don't have the book use the online version https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=BXgW9UCgpc8</p> <p>Make a tea party for you and the tiger. What do you think the tiger would like to eat?</p> 	<p>Flour Writing</p> <p>Place some flour onto a clean baking tray. Children can use their finger to make marks and patterns in the flour. An adult can model writing letters and numbers in the flour for the children to copy.</p>
