I will be learning to....

## Mathematics

- count, recognise and order numbers to 10 then 20
- match numbers to groups to 10.
- say the number one more/less than a given number up to 10.
- Describe the position of objects, people and places
- relate addition to combining two or more groups of objects.
- name and describe simple 2D shapes .

### Literacy

I will be learning to...

- hold a pencil correctly
- recognise and write my name.
- know the different sounds that letters make (phonics)
- recognise sounds in words
- begin to put sounds together to spell words
- write simple CVC words
- write for a purpose e.g. making lists, labelling pictures, making signs.
- re-tell stories
- talk about characters and events in story books

I will be learning to...

- talk about myself
- listen carefully to others
- imagine and recreate roles in real life family situations and fictional stories
- asking questions to find things out
- answer questions about myself
- listen to stories and rhymes
- use an increasing range of vocabulary

### Expressive Arts and Design

I will be learning to...

- explore sounds and move to music
- paint and draw self portraits
- sing familiar songs
- listen to musical instruments and move to music
- use my body to make sounds
- name and mix colours
- explore 2D and 3D art

### Understanding the World

I will be learning to...

- talk about similarities and differences between my friends
- use iPads to take photos of my friends
- use my five senses to investigate area around me
- talk about seasonal changes and go on local walks around the school.
- find out about the different parts of the body.
- find out about people who help us and the jobs they do
